# **ART ALLIANCE PROGRAM**



Our members have all been in awe of the artists and stories which Denise Kraemer, our Program Chair, has brought to Art Alliance over the past two years. Her introductions and banter and anecdotes are spontaneous, on point and often the take away thought of the evening. We hope you will invite family and friends to come and here Denise speak for herself as an artist at our general meeting program on Thursday, September 19<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 PM at the Julia Morgan Building.

Denise Kraemer is a native of the Inland Empire. Even before she discovered printmaking, Denise found herself drawn to artists like Henri de Toulouse-Lautrec, Kathi Kowitz, and Alfonso Mucha. This fascination with their style of work lured her to take her first printmaking class. Like

these artists, her work tends to be organic in style. Kraemer will tell you that printmaking perfectly unites her analytical left brain and her creative right brain allowing her to process, alter, and develop ideals, satisfying her inquisitive nature. Each print lends itself to a finite progression of discovery, which is the driving force of her work.

She served as the Education Curator at the Riverside Art Museum in Riverside, California for 3 years, where she organizes the adult education programs, monthly lecture series and member critiques. A founding member of Riverside Independent Printmakers (RIP), Kraemer curated the printmaking exhibition *Pressed* at the Riverside Art Museum and has worked with the museum's "Monothon" workshop and exhibition for 4 years. Kraemer received her BA in Art from California Baptist University and her MA in Art/printmaking at California State University San Bernardino.

This year, she had a solo exhibition at Riverside Art Museum, three group shows this summer and worked with the Arts Connection and Mil Tree in Joshua Tree, CA. She teaches an ongoing weekly printmaking workshop at Division 9 gallery. She teaches printmaking at Riverside Community College and California State University at San Bernardino.

At the Riverside Mayors Ball, hosted by the Riverside Arts Council in March of 2024, Denise was awarded 3<sup>rd</sup> place in the 'Wild Card' category. She is a tireless champion of the arts in Riverside and the discovery of art within each of us. Please welcome our very own Denise Kraemer.



### Parliamentarian: Proposed Policy Changes

#### ART ALLIANCE POLICIES

During our summer hiatus the Parliamentarian and committee have been working on the Membership portions of the Policies of the Art Alliance. We have updated the Membership Categories, Requirement, Qualifications, Termination Membership Officer and Dues. Our changes are to provide clarity and simplicity for our members. Please see the portions provided for you below. We will be voting on these changes at our September 19, 2024 General Meeting.

Article 2.01 Categories MEMBERSHIP:

#### Art Alliance membership year is from June 1<sup>st</sup> through May 31<sup>st</sup>

The Categories of Art Alliance membership

Active (A) – required to work actively on fundraisers and special events.

Supporting (S) – encouraged to support the fundraisers and special events.

RAM Life (L) – Those Art Alliance members who qualified for RAM Life membership are exempt from Art Alliance dues. (RAM no longer offers a Life Membership.) All members are required to maintain current RAM membership.

#### CHANGE TO:

The Categories of Art Alliance membership are Active and Supporting: Active Member's Requirements:

Pay \$25 annual dues.

Sign up for least one of the project committees or serve on the Art Alliance Board.

*Expected to* volunteer to help during the fall and spring fundraising events. *Encouraged* to volunteer for other projects and events as their schedules permit. Attend as many general meetings as possible. Maintain a current RAM membership.

Supporting Member's Requirements:

Pay \$100 annual dues.

*Expected* to volunteer to help during the fall and spring fundraising events. *Encouraged* to volunteer for other projects and events as their schedules permit.

**RAM Life (S/L)** No change from the directory.

2.02 **Qualifications:** Members will support the mission of the organization. Members are encouraged to attend general meetings, Art Alliance events and RAM events. **CHANGE TO:** 

Qualifications: Members will support the mission of the organization.

2.03 **Termination:** Any member who is delinquent in Art Alliance and/or RAM dues will be dropped from membership.

CHANGE TO:

Termination: Any member who is delinquent in Art Alliance dues will be dropped from the membership.

2.04 **Resignation:** A member may resign by submitting a resignation letter to the Membership Chair. No change from the directory.

Article 4: Officers

**Membership**: Beginning in April, the Membership Chair will encourage active and supporting members to sponsor prospective members. The Chair will arrange an information meeting for prospective members in September and guide the new members during their first year. The Chair is responsible for maintaining membership status changes in the directory and newsletters. The Chair and new members responsible for decorating the Holiday tree at RAM. **CHANGE TO:** 

Membership: The Chair will arrange an information meeting for new members in September. Throughout the year, the Chair welcomes new members with an email and provides a copy of the directory, as well as works to guide the new members during their first year. The Chair is responsible for maintaining membership status changes and communicating any changes to the Art Alliance Board as well as the rest of the Art Alliance. The Chair and new members are responsible for decorating the Holiday tree and the fireplace mantle at RAM and then removing the decorations.

Article 5: Finance

5.02 **Dues** 

Dues notices will be sent by April 15<sup>th</sup> each year and are due by May 15<sup>th</sup>. If dues haven not been received by June 30<sup>th</sup>membership will be dropped. Membership dues will be: Active - \$25 per year. Supporting - \$100 per year. Dues are for the administrative operation of the Art

Alliance.

CHANGE TO:

Emails for Membership renewal and dues payment will be sent out in March. Members whose dues have not been received by May 31 are *considered* delinquent. Membership annal due are: Active: \$25. Supporting: \$100. Dues are for the administrative operation of the Art Alliance.

Judy Davies is a celebrated Southern California artist known for her commercial and private work in leaded glass, fused glass, enamel, ink and watercolor. Judy has been a member of the Riverside Art Museum and Art Alliance for over 50 years and contributed to many of RAM's events, including being an instrumental member of the team who envisioned the annual Christmas Tree Brunch that featured many of her stained glass works, as well as stained glass ornaments trees. Judy was the creator of the Olympic-themed windows for Riverside City College's Administration building in 1984 and her work can still be viewed in Riverside courthouses, banks, the March Air Force Base Chapel and at the adolescent Behavioral Medicine Center at Loma Linda University.

#### Treasurer's Talk September 2024

Attached are the May, June, and July financials. These reflect income and expenses from our Annual Dinner, the income from Membership renewals, and the remaining expenses from Art Market. Our \$3,000 donation to Art Education/Scholarship also shows up. Our balance at the end of July was \$30,674.99

Over the summer, the reconciliation of Art Market took place, and the transfer of credit card artist fees and sponsorships took place in August. While the financials for August are not complete, we know the additional income is already in our account. As a result, I am thrilled to announce that the profit from Art Market 2024 was \$33,223.90. The Art Alliance Board approved \$34,000 to be donated to RAM. Congratulations to Kathy Christmas and Debra Johnson (chairs), their entire team, and all who worked so hard to make this such a successful event. Awesome work Art Alliance...and a great way to start our 2024-25 fiscal year.
